Narration or thought balloon: (Dog) Ahhh (yawn), Another wonderful day!
Scene 2 Breakfast		Food bowl	Clanging sound of food being poured into the bowl. Cutting sound of the "special treat" that goes on top of dog's breakfast. Shoot dog's view in kitchen. Shoot dog walking to dish. Shoot food.	Dog eats breakfast. Narration or thought balloon: What's she making for my breakfast? Oh, it looks like it's going to be good! Mmmmmm...
Scene 3 People prepare for their day		Kitchen	Lunch making sounds. Coffee being poured. Toaster popping toast. Shoot the preparation from the dog's point of view. Shoot the dog sitting in the hallway watching.	Dog sits in kitchen watching people prepare their lunches, breakfast and coffee. Walking around kitchen. Narration or thought balloon: I can't wait until they sit down to eat breakfast.
